As directed by Governor Burgum, Manvel School will be closed until the end of March. At which point we will begin offering alternative educational opportunities to our students.

With the recent mandatory school closings related to the coronavirus (COVID-19) in North Dakota, we want to update our families and tell you about what we're doing to minimize risks of infection.

We have taken action to deep clean the school. If you have not had a chance to pick up your child's belongings, please call the school office to arrange a time to stop in as soon as possible. We are asking all families to please wash and disinfect your child's belongings. Let us know if your child will need a Chromebook for grades 4-8. If your child is in grades PK-3 please be sure to pick up their educational packet in the office. Additionally, plan to pick up your child's band instrument so that you may clean and disinfect it.

All Manvel Teachers have been working diligently to put together 10 days of *Educational Learning Opportunities for all of our students*. The third quarter ended last week. Teachers are working on report cards and they will be sent home soon. We were to begin the North Dakota State Assessment in March for grades 3-8. This test is mandated by the Department of Education each year. North Dakota Department of Public Instruction has submitted a waiver for North Dakota students to be

exempt from taking the state test this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We are waiting to hear back about the decision. Once we do, we will let you know.

The end of the school year will look much different than usual. Many of our activities and events will be postponed until further notice. During this situation, we ask that you continue to remain calm, enjoy this time at home with your children and give each other grace and care as we practice social distancing across the country in order to keep us all healthy and safe. We will continue to work with state and local agencies on a daily basis to receive updates and guidance.
